New and Improved!!

As some of you know, Eric Will Gym Center was established in 1982 built from the ground up. Fast-forwarding to now, he has made a well-known name for himself throughout the gymnastics industry. As the gym continues to grow, there has been some noticeable outdated wear and tear areas that were in need of some updating.

Over the past few months we have been making some changes to our facility. These upgrades have taken place to better accommodate your experience and comfort. Some changes made are as followed.

When entering the gym area, we have altered the vault runway and walkway to better accommodate the traffic between classes and to allow strollers and wheelchairs to be easily maneuvered and accessed.

In the viewing area we have updated the tiling as well as the padding on the bleachers for better comfort and style.

We have been replacing and adding equipment throughout the gym to better accommodate the gymnast during their training.

We have changed out the landing mat at the end of the tumble track along with some of the bar mats, and several of our crash mats have been switched out as well. Our team beams have been resurfaced leaving a presentable brand-new look.

We would like to thank our maintenance team for taking part in these changes. We are proud to have them working behind the scenes reinforcing the cleanliness and comfort of our facility.

Our summer camp program is designed to keep your children active and productive. Besides the gymnastics dynamics of camp, we offer several activities throughout the day including: Arts and crafts which is held in our upstairs preschool room.
